Agenda Item 5. Status of Alameda County Mayors' Conference Tax Exempt Status

At some time in its history, the Alameda County Mayors' Conference received tax-exempt status, most likely by becoming a 501(c)(4) organization. A 501(c)(4) organization is generally defined as a nonprofit organization that has a primary purpose of promoting social welfare, which includes community benefit and political advocacy. It can also engage in political activities, provided they are not its primary purpose. Organizations with 501(c)(4) status typically include civic leagues, homeowners associations, civic groups, etc. Retaining tax-exempt status had required filing an annual Form 990-EZ. The City of San Leandro has handled the filings on behalf of the Mayors' Conference.

The federal and California state governments have notified the City of San Leandro that the Mayors' Conference's tax-exempt status has been revoked due to failure to submit the annual tax-exemption forms.

To address this situation, the City of San Leandro is in the process of completing the forms necessary to reinstate the Mayors' Conference's tax-exempt status. Staff will keep the Committee informed as this process moves forward.
